We're taking the next step in this adventure! We've sold about half of our possessions, given many things away, and sent the rest to North Carolina and Rhode Island for long-term storage. It's amazing how many things can accumulate over time, and how good it feels to clean it out and bless others with it! We left Orlando on August 8. From August 10-September 7 we will be in cross-cultural training (ICC) at Wycliffe's JAARS center in Waxhaw, NC.

We have resigned our paid positions. Our income from this point forward will come from your gifts. Following ICC we will be continuing to build a team of prayer and financial partners to send us to Nairobi, Kenya. Wycliffe will release us to our assignments when our team is complete and Wycliffe is receiving 100% of the funds needed for our ministry. Our faith goal is to arrive in Nairobi by January 2008.

## LOOKING AHEAD

We will be visiting a number of areas to share our story, to build awareness of the needs of people without God's Word in their own language and to invite people to join our team of prayer and financial partners. Wycliffe calls this *partnership development*.

Here's our schedule for the next few months:

- August 8-September 7—Cross cultural training, Waxhaw, NC
- September 8-mid-October—Partnership development in the south and mid-west
- Mid-October-November 13— Partnership development in New England
- November 14-December 15— Partnership development in southern California and the southwest
- December 16-January— Partnership development in New England
- January— Depart for Kenya if our partnership team is complete and our ministry is fully funded by that time. Please pray! We also invite you to consider joining our team if you haven't already.
